## **IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

### **ISA Registration halted & the impact on CRB application process**

Fellow Lions

As you may now be aware, the Government has announced their intention to remodel the Vetting and Baring Scheme (VBS) back to proportionate, commonsense levels. As a result, the ISA registration phase of the scheme has now been stopped and therefore will **NOT** launch on the 26<sup>th</sup> July 2010.

Although the full details and scope of this remodelling are still to be finalised:

- It is business as usual for the Criminal Records Bureau (CRB)
- The elements of the VBS put in place back in October 2009 continue: and existing requirements concerning CRB will remain in place, and those entitled to such checks can continue to apply for them.
- There is still NO CHARGE for Lions.
- The new Purple CRB Application forms **must be used for applications, and will be accepted by the Criminal Records Bureau from the 28<sup>th</sup> July.**
- **The bureau will not accept any applications on the old white forms after 20<sup>th</sup> July 2010.**

## **IMPORTANT**

If clubs are holding any old white CRB application forms will they please shred them, and contact either myself, Andy Shiner or Ken Hart for the new PURPLE forms which will have clear instructions on how they should be completed.
