

Deaths of Lions and Partners

In the event of the death of one of your Club members, or their partner, please immediately advise District Almoner Lion Ted Graham AND MMR Officer Lion Peter Rowe (details in MD Directory) giving details of next-of-kin and, as soon as known, funeral arrangements. This procedure may also, if the Club deem it appropriate, apply to the death of a former Club member.

Your Zone Chairman and neighbouring clubs should also be advised.

Lion Ted will then liaise with the Governor to ensure that the District pays its proper respects.

If your Club wishes to submit an Obituary it should be sent direct to Editor Margaret Kimberley (for the Lion magazine) or to Newsletter Editor Lion Judith John for the District Newsletter.
