

LIONS CLUBS INTERNATIONAL DISTRICT 105SW

DISTRICT SCRAPBOOK COMPETITION RULES

The Scrapbook is a record of the Presidential Year and will be judged at the annual District Convention. The winning Club will be awarded The Cyril J. Harbud Memorial Cup.

1. Description of entries

- a) All entries must be in book form, not exceeding 24" x 36" (60cm x 90cm).
- b) All entries must be clearly defined on the front cover.

2. Contents

- a) The Scrapbook should cover the period of the preceding Presidential Year. Where the book is in a continuous format, judging will only take place on material covering the specified year.
- b) Newspaper and magazine coverage supported by clippings.
- c) Bulletins, Newsletters, Function Programmes, Menus, Tickets, etc.
- d) Photographs and Pictures.

3. Participation

- a) All Clubs shall be eligible to submit an entry to the District Scrapbook Competition.
- b) Each entry shall be delivered to the District Competitions Co-ordinator prior to the District Convention and Clubs will be responsible for the collection of their Scrapbook after the close of Convention.

4. Judging

- a) Entries will be judged by a panel of judges approved by the District Governor
- b) Judging will be on maximum marks awarded as follows:-
 - 65% News Media Coverage
 - 25% Club and Inter-Club Activities
 - 10% Presentation
- c) The results will be announced and the Memorial Cup presented to the winning Club during District Convention

5. Memorial Cup

- a) The Memorial Cup shall be held by the winning Club for one year.
- b) The winning Club shall be responsible for the Cup for twelve months, for engraving the Club's name on the Cup (in similar style to previous years) and delivering the Cup to the District Competitions Co-ordinator prior to the following District Convention in a clean state.

6. Multiple District Scrapbook Competition

The winning entry shall be eligible for entry to the MD Convention Scrapbook Competition. It shall be the winning Club's responsibility to deliver the Scrapbook to the MD Convention and collect it afterwards.
