2010 is fast approaching and Convention draws ever closer. On behalf of the Convention Committee I would like to thank all those who have submitted their Booking Form. To those who have not yet done so can I please urge you to get them in now. This also includes those of you who will only be attending the Business Sessions on Saturday 13th March. The Booking Form can be downloaded from the District Website. **I must remind you that Buffet Lunch on the Saturday is an optional extra and should be pre-booked required. It will consist of a choice of two filled rolls and coffee at a cost of £5.00 per head.**

Car Parking will be in the outside car park where we have exclusive use and this will be monitored by Lions. If you are not attending all the events please be careful that you do not get blocked in until the Sunday morning as the intention is that we get as many cars in there as possible. Details of overflow spaces will be available when you arrive. For those of you who will only be coming to the Business Sessions I would recommend that you use Park and Ride. Other than that there are of course the usual City Centre pay and display car parks.

The Convention Registration Desk will be located to the left of the entrance lobby and will be open from 2.00 to 5.00pm on Friday and 8.30 to 9.45am on Saturday. Registration for rooms at the Hotel will commence from 2.00pm on Friday. Coffee will be available in the Bar.

Party Night, Saturday Business Session, DG's Gala Dinner and the informal session on Sunday morning will all take place in the Mariner Suite which is located to the right of the entrance lobby. The District Officers Exhibitions will be displayed in the corridor outside the Mariner Suite.

For those attending Friday Party Night and Saturday Buffet Lunch please remember that you will need to produce your tickets which will be included in your Convention Pack.

We have introduced an outing for the Ladies/Partners visiting Mount Edgcombe House and then the scenic drive along Whitsand Cliffs in South East Cornwall to the Edinburgh Woollen Mill Outlet at Trerulefoot. The cost will be £20.00. Please pre-book on the Booking Form "C" where there are more details

Everyone attending the Business Session should take their seats in the Mariner Suite by 9.50am, however, the Lions Youth 4 Brass Band will be playing in there prior to that, which will give everyone the opportunity to hear them play, so please try and keep the noise down and not interfere with their music after all it is for you!
