### **Mount Edcumbe House and Country Park & the Rame Peninsula**

We are sure that after three years in Plymouth you will have seen enough of what the City's shops have to offer. The Committee therefore decided to offer you the chance to escape and visit the lovely Rame Peninsula taking in Mount Edcumbe House, a scenic drive along the Whitsand Cliffs, finishing up at the Edinburgh Woollen Mill Outlet at Trerulefoot. This beautiful area of coast is frequently missed by visitors who continue on down the A38. Mount Edcumbe House is the former home of the Earls of Mount Edcumbe. Set in Grade I Cornish Gardens within 865 acres Country Park on the Rame Peninsula, South East Cornwall. Mount Edcumbe House was first built in the 1500s and was restored after World War Two. It is jointly owned by Cornwall Council and Plymouth City Council and is one of the regions most popular historic tourist destinations. Refreshments will be available at both Mount Edcumbe and also at Trerulefoot at an additional cost.

The excursion will depart following the Opening Ceremony for Convention and return mid afternoon.
