Many of you have asked for the link to the 'Know How' document on the MD website, giving guidance regarding running a Prostate Cancer screening event – this is just an update to say it is **currently being reviewed** (as some of the information was out of date).

Rest assured as soon as it is updated, I will send out another email, telling you where you can find the document and sending you the link (as I know there have been some difficulties around this).

I want to thank you all for your replies so far – a copy is attached to this e-mail in case yours went astray!

To date I have received 200 returns out of 601 Clubs, so if you haven't replied **please** could you do so, this is to enable me to have all the information gathered together when it is discussed at MD level in the coming months.
